

you that Kendor Day Nursery is a nursery where your child will feel safe, secure and above all feel like they are in a family environment. Our nursery is warm and welcoming with staff who aim to offer your child the best experiences for them to start their new adventure at nursery. As professionals we nurture their learning by providing a wide range of opportunity and resources.

The nursery focuses on encouraging children's independence and choice to support their learning. We encourage fun through freedom of choice, child initiative activities along with adult initiative activities.

TRAINING

In order to be most effective it is important that all staff remain up to date with current developments in the Early Years. We provide staff with access to high quality training but are very aware that we need to show how this has impacted on our practice. Our observations have noted higher levels of engagement and involvement. We also have 1 day inset per year so that all staff can be up to date.

- All staff have paediatric first aid training
- All have had current safeguarding training and I have had safer recruitment training (contained in the Level 3 safeguarding training).
- The SENCO has on-going training and attends monthly SENCO forums
- 2 members of staff have attended Developing Learning Outside at West Thornton Primary Academy
- All staff have had training for behaviour management
- All staff have had a day's training on planning

STAFF

There are 7 members of staff, including myself. We pride ourselves on our retention of staff as 4 members of staff have been here since we opened in July 2010. Two other members of staff have worked here for 3 years, after completing their apprenticeships in the setting.

OFSTED

Ofsted (2013) graded our setting as "Good." We were told it had the potential to be outstanding.

The report stated that

"It is not yet outstanding because: In some areas the planning structure does not always promote children's independence fully."

PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

WHAT WOULD I NEED TO DO?

A registration fee of £30.00 will be payable on registering your child at the nursery (please note that this amount is not refundable) the registration fee covers administration and secures a place on our registers.

We will contact you to arrange start dates and settling in dates.

- The availability of places are selected on a first come first serve basis, with the child's age and space available in the required room.
- In the event of a place not being available your details will be placed onto a waiting list and the nursery manager will contact you when a place becomes available.

OPENING HOURS

We are closed for one week during the summer and one week between Christmas Day and New Year's Day.

Fees will be charged at the rates indicated above and payable strictly in advance. In failure to do so this will incur a late payment fee of £20.00 a day until payment has been received. Fees will be reviewed yearly and you will be advised of any changes with a months' notice.

WHAT HAPPENS IF I JUST WANT THE 15 HRS ENTITLEMENT FOR TWO YEAR OLDS AND THREE YEAR OLDS?

That's fine. We offer a stretch package over 5 days.

This means your child will attend 5 days per week from 9.00 am to 12.00pm.
